Q: What should my child bring to camp?

Players should bring:

Q: Where do I drop off and Pick-up my child from camp?

All pick up and camp drop-off is done at our PPA HITHOUSE indoor facility. 100 Crimea Street. There is ample free on-site parking.

Q: How is health and safety managed?
